By the time First Term report cards go home on Dec. 8th, parents should already have a good understanding of their child's efforts and achievements at school, and of the ways in which they can support their child's learning from home.

#### FIELD TRIPS

There are a couple of upcoming field trips that will require special parent meetings (to be scheduled in January).

Mt. Cain Ski Trip: (Grade 2-7) January 29th-bus will leave Sea View School at approximately 7:30 a.m. for Mt. Cain. Costs will be \$20.00 per student with the remaining expenses being covered by PAC.
